

AGREEMENT OF COOPERATION FOR EMERGENCY SERVICES

This agreement of cooperation for Emergency Services, made this 15 day of January, 1987, between the Emergency Government Committee of the Washburn County Board of Supervisors, (hereinafter "Committee"), the Washburn County Highway Department (hereinafter "Department"), the (Town, ~~Village~~, City) of Bashaw (hereinafter "Municipality") is made pursuant to Sections 166.03(7)(b) and 66.30, Stats.

1. EMERGENCY SERVICES. It is understood by the parties that the term "Emergency Services" means those services undertaken to minimize the effects of enemy action and natural or manmade disasters. For purposes of this agreement, "Emergency Services" are provided by the Department to the Municipality, coordinated by the Committee, and shall consist of the provision of heavy equipment and operators for the immediate cleanup of disasters in the interest of community health and welfare.


2. INITIATING EMERGENCY SERVICES. It is further understood by the parties that, in the event of a disaster requiring Emergency Services under the jurisdiction of the Municipality occurs, the Municipality shall make all reasonable efforts to retain the services of a private contractor before availing itself of Emergency Services by contacting the head of Emergency Government for Washburn County. It is the intention of the parties that Emergency Services shall be available to the Municipality only if a private contractor is not immediately available and time is of the essence.

3. BEARING OF COSTS AND LOSSES. The Municipality shall bear

the reasonable costs of labor and equipment time of the Department for Emergency Services provided. Pursuant to Section 166.03(9), Stats., the Department is responsible for any loss from the damage to or destruction of the Department's equipment utilized in any authorized emergency government activity.

4. TERMINATION. This contract may be terminated by either party by filing with the secretary of the department of administration a certified copy of a resolution to that effect.


5. EXECUTION. A copy of this agreement shall be filed with the secretary of the department of administration within 10 days of execution.
