

DRIVEWAY SNOWPLOWING - RELEASE OF CLAIM

In consideration for driveway snowplowing services performed by the Town of Bashaw, or it's designee, I agree to the following terms and conditions:

- 1) Driveway or Private Road will meet the minimum standards of 20' wide and 20' overhead height, and be kept free of obstructions (i.e. overhanging branches, stumps, etc) which may be hazardous to the snowplow or operator. There must be adequate area for the plow to turn around.
- 2) Driveway or Private Road will be kept free of all property which could be subject to damage by the snowplowing equipment.
- 3) I understand that driveways or private roads will not be plowed for small amounts of snow or when the ground is not substantially frozen (late fall, early spring) to prevent damage to the area by the plow. Roads will be opened first and driveways second. The plow will only open the driveway or road to provide access.
- 4) Plows will not be sent out to do a specific driveway or road because of late payment. You must be on the list to get plowed or wait until the plow returns to your area.
- 5) Town of Bashaw will determine the length of a private road or driveway.
- 6) I agree that the Town of Bashaw, or it's designee, officials and/or employees will not be held liable for any damage to any property encountered in the area to be snowplowed.
- 7) This agreement will remain in effect unless: service is discontinued by Town action, conditions are not met, Town or Signer cancels service, non-payment.
