- CALL MEETING TO ORDER
- MINUTES FROM OCTOBER 13, 2020 MEETING: Motion by Johnson to approve the October 13, 2020 minutes, second by Degner. M.C. Yes (3) Kelbel, Degner, Johnson.
- **TREASURER'S REPORT:** Motion by Degner to approve, second by Johnson. M.C. Yes (3) Kelbel, Degner, Johnson.
- CORRESPONDENCE: Kelbel received a highway department on call schedule and he forwarded that to Bill. Kelbel gave Dahlstrom a MFL notice for cutting. Kelbel received a letter of agreement for material pick up from Washburn County Highway Department that needs to be completed and a copy of the insurance provided. Kelbel discussed obtaining salt/sand from the City of Shell Lake and at this time not feasible as we do not have a storage site or way to load the material.
- **PUBLIC INPUT:** Samson expressed his concerns in regards to closing the Long Lake boat landing and only allowing foot traffic. He has fond memories and would like to see it maintained as a landing. Taubman observed that the school did utilize this site during the summer school program. Taubman had observed in Guatemala the usage of tires for stairways and thought that may be an option.

- **ROADS:** Taubman stated there were still a few roads that they would like to get graded. They did some driveway patching along the shoulders on Sand Road as discussed previously. One tire on the grader was continually loosing air. After changing out the tires A&A Tire repaired the tire that was loosing air as it had a screw in the tire. A new starter had to be replaced on the truck. The tailgate release does not operate correctly and does not open properly.
