- CALL MEETING TO ORDER/PLEDGE-Chairperson Degner called meeting to order @ 6:36 p.m.
- MINUTES FROM MARCH 15, 2022 MEETING-Motion made by Damon to accept the minutes, 2nd by Kelbel. All in favor (3) Degner, Damon, Kelbel, No (0). Motion carried.
- **TREASURERS REPORT**-Dahlstrom reported the beginning statement balance as of March 1st is \$104,182.30, 2 deposits, 1 for \$70 for driveways and \$4.11 in interest, \$20,774.56 checks that cleared leaving an ending statement balance of \$83,481.85. Outstanding checks and April disbursements=\$27,068.38. Checking ending balance=\$56,413.47. Motion made by Kelbel to approve the treasurers report, 2nd Damon. Yes (3) Degner, Damon, Kelbel. No (0). Motion carried.
- CORRESPONDENCE-Degner reported that the township got a capital credit statement from Barron Electric in the amount of \$1155. Degner also reported about the emergency meeting the state had the previous day regarding the Avian Bird Flu and the concern was the semi-trucks trucking out birds on weight restricted roads. The only turkey farm in our township is Bush's off Hwy O so we don't really have anything to worry about now. WI Towns meeting Wednesday, April 27th @ 7pm at the Washburn County Government Center in Shell Lake. Damon reported he had a phone call from Daryl Snell thanking the township for clearing the corner on Tozer Lake Road. he had multiple insurance certificates come in as well as a letter from Habitat for Humanity.
- ARPA-Degner reports nothing new on this.
- **PUBLIC INPUT**-Burnham inquired about the ambulance. There was discussion about the Cumberland Ambulance Service and the increased costs of North Ambulance Service.
- DRIVEWAY PERMITS/APPLICATIONS-None.
- 2 YEAR ROAD PLAN-Degner received an email from Brian Danielson on the LRIP project (Swiss Chalet Rd). Brian budgeted a 10% increase on blacktop, and it went up over 20%. Brian needed an official list of their 2022 Road Plan. Road Tour took place on April 4th. Discussion took place on 2-year road plan. Road plan is as follows: 1. Swiss Chalet Road, entirety. Place gravel, grind, grade and blacktop #2. New Knapp Rd. maintenance of water shed on hills. #3. Hilltop Rd from new blacktop to Spring Lake Rd. Pave. #4. Sand Rd (Approximately 3 miles) from Sunset Rd to the intersection of Spring Lake Rd. Place gravel, grind, grade, and blacktop #5. Spring Lake Rd. Place gravel, grind and grade. #6. Loop Rd from Hector Dam Rd to USH 70, possible blacktop

- **ROADS**-Degner discussed the need to lower the speed limit on Green Valley Rd. Temporary signs were put out already. Kelbel made a motion to radify placement of speed limit signs from 55 mph to 45 mph. 2nd Damon. Yes (3) Degner, Damon, Kelbel. No (0). Motion carried. Taubman will get Deaf Child sign back up on Old Rd B. Taubman reports a culvert on Cadle Rd washed out with the last storm. They had to add 60 yards of gravel as it washed the road out. He will get Amber the expenses to submit to Carol Buck for Disaster Aide. Degner already submitted the pictures. If approved, they will cover 70% of the repair. Degner reported this Road Tour was the best the roads have ever been.
- TRUCK/GRADER-Taubman discussed the need for painting the grader again. Meltons Sandblasting won't be able to do it and neither will Farleys. He will keep looking. Discussion took place on the truck that was ordered, nothing new on that. The tires on the grader will need to be rotated.
